## Jamboree Medical Forms

Staff, leaders, and participants are asked to “hold off” scheduling their jamboree medical exam until they have received a personalized form via email from the jamboree division.

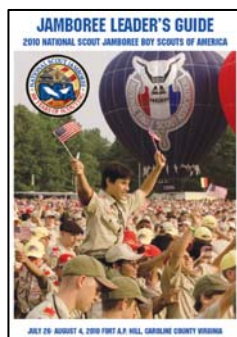
Basically, during the next month or so, each registered staff member, leader, and participant will be emailed a BSA medical form for completion by their physician prior to the jamboree. It will look very much like the current BSA medical form, but will feature the addition of a bar code that has that person’s name, etc. encoded within it. We’re asked to use that form **ONLY**.

This also points out the need for anyone who has **changed their email address** to be sure it is correct in the jamboree registration system.
